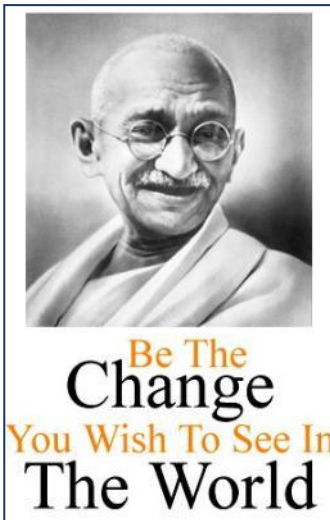


Famous People
